 - An active member is consistent in their participation in various spiritual and other fellowshiporiented activities at NMBC
- Meet the requirements of a NMBC's non-traditional student definition
 - o Pursuing a degree at least one year after completing high school or earning a GED
- Complete an application
- Include the following:
 - o A letter of recommendation from a Member of NMBC or Employer or a Professor, Administrator or Advisor from the last University/College attended
 - Certified copy of your high school diploma/GED or the most current transcript from the last University/College attended
- Submit an essay 500 words or less in response to the following: As a member of Nazarene Missionary Baptist Church, please list a sermon topic that positively influenced you. How did you apply it to your life or how do you plan to apply it in the future?

You are responsible for ensuring all supporting documents are submitted on time

- The deadline for submitting a complete application is on or before April 2, 2023
