Our Program

Our Boys 2 Men initiative in Evansville, IN, is the local chapter of a “Not for Profit” 501(c)3 program, chartered in Indianapolis, IN. Its founder, Dr. Lars Rascoe, III, saw a need to rescue young inner-city boys from the temptations and potential bad choices they faced in schools and on the streets, when not surrounded by strong positive role models. He created the Boys 2 Men Program to provide a place where these boys could get off the streets and fellowship with other boys who are interested in a better way of life. Every Friday night they enjoy recreational activities, guest speakers and encourage each other on how to grow and develop.

In 2009, our Executive Sponsor, the Rev. Larry Rascoe, Sr. pulled together a group of local men to meet with Dr. Rascoe, to explore the creation of a Boys 2 Men Chapter in Evansville. In Aug. 2010 we held our first session here in Evansville. Under the guidance provided by the Indy Chapter, and supported by the use of the facilities at Impact Ministries, we started our meetings on the 2nd and 4th Fridays of each month. We have tried to provide guidance and positive reinforcement to our young boys (Cadets), to help them make good choices for their personal development.

Our program recently transitioned to meetings on the 1st and 3rd Fridays of each month. We now utilize the facilities at Joshua Charter School. However, our mission, to serve young boys (Cadets), remains the same.

Our Goal

We want to serve as support for parents and teachers in helping the Cadets to turn away from all the negatives issues they may face and encourage them as they make positive decisions. We want to build relationships of trust to give the Cadets another person they can turn to in times of personal confusion. We want to expose the Cadets to positive role models and career options, to influence their life choices. We want to help these young men to know what it truly means to be a successful and respected young man!

PROGRESS REPORT PASS-PORT

OBJECTIVE:

Pass-ports are just one of the ways we encourage the Cadets to stay connected with their teachers. By personally asking their teachers for a progress report on a regular basis, we hope the Cadet can convey to their teachers that they care about their grades and are trying.

This tool will also be used by the Parents and Mentors to work with the Cadet on an ongoing basis. We can look to encourage good progress and intervene, early, where we might see a weakness.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Pass-ports must be turned in as your ticket to enter the session.
- Pass-ports must have a parent or guardian signature.
- Pass-ports must be filled out and completed by assigned teachers with their signatures.

CONSEQUENCES:

Boys 2 Men has a 'point system' to recognize top achievers in our program. It is also used to earn participation in special activities and trips.

Pass-ports are one tool that we use to allow the Cadets to accumulate points. Failure to provide the pass-ports will result in a lost opportunity to earn these points.

If a Cadet, by their actions, indicates they are not willing to participate in the pass-portal process, they may be asked to leave the program. This issue will be discussed with the parents before any action is taken.
