- **Meet the requirements of a NMBC's non-traditional student definition**
 - **Pursuing a degree at least one year after completing high school or earning a GED**
- Complete an application
- Include the following:
 - A letter of recommendation from a Member of NMBC or Employer or a Professor, Administrator or Advisor from the last University/College attended
 - Certified copy of your high school diploma/GED or the most current transcript from the last University/College attended
- Submit an essay, minimum of 500 words, in response to the following: As a member of Nazarene Missionary Baptist Church, please list a sermon topic that positively influenced you. How did you apply it to your life or how do you plan to apply it in the future?

- The deadline for submitting a complete application is on or before April 26, 2026
